

**CPDSS RELEASE NOTES PATCH – September 2002**  
**Version 1.7.1.0.A**

	<b><i>ENHANCEMENTS</i></b>
<b>DEROS Information</b>	You can now review information concerning overseas eligibility. This information is located on the General/TIG tab. This tab provides such information as the 5-year overseas limit expiration date; Overseas Tour Ext Exp date; Overseas Tour Exp Date; Travel Agreement PCS Expiration date; and OS Tour Expire Exemption. A column has been added to the CRR called “Overseas Eligibility” that will display a ‘Y’ (Yes) or “N.” (No) to advise if data is contained in these fields.
<b>Personnel Security Clearance Information</b>	The personnel security clearance information is now being displayed on the General/TIG tab.
<b>Acquisition Data Elements</b>	The Acquisition Tab and Report now contains Acquisition Corps Qualified, Acquisition Contracting Officer Qualified, and Acquisition 1102 Series Qualified information
<b>Job Analysis Promotion Plan Template - Internal Element</b>	The Internal Element has been enhanced to include the following “And Logic” restrictions: Acquisition Corps Qualified, Acquisition Contracting Officer Qualified, and Acquisition 1102 Series Qualified.
<b>Referral Brief</b>	The Acquisition Corps Qualified Date was added to the Corps Status section of the Referral Brief report along with the Acquisition Corps Qualified Basis and associated clear text
<b>Open Continuous Announcement</b>	The capability is now available for multiple CRR pulls against a single Resumix Requisition. Additional guidance on this enhancement can be found in the “Open Continuous Announcement Training Guide”.
	<b><i>FIXED ITEMS</i></b>
<b>Resumix Custom Field</b>	PROBLEM: The Resumix custom field name used to retrieve the Servicing Personnel Office ID restriction was pulling information from the “Servicing CPF” instead of the CCPO ID. <b>FIX: <i>The system has been re-designed to pull data from the CCPO ID.</i></b>
<b>Appointment Type</b>	PROBLEM: The Internal element restriction “Appointment Type is currently looking at the appointment type in the Experience History Assignment record when evaluating this restriction. <b>FIX: <i>The application has been modified to look at the Appointment Type of the current assignment.</i></b>
<b>Experience History Maintenance - Assignment Effective Date</b>	PROBLEM: The current position “effective start date” is not correct on the Experience History Maintenance display screen. <b>FIX: <i>The “Date Start Current Position” as well as the Assignment Effective Start Date is now displayed on the Experience History Maintenance display screen.</i></b>
<b>Error Codes 34 &amp; 35</b>	PROBLEM: Currently the Error Code 34 encompasses errors in which a data validation check failed during the import of data for a candidate record and also identifies overall database errors. <b>FIX: <i>The system will now display two error codes; code 34 will display errors pertaining to individual candidates while error code 35 will display errors pertaining to the database. The errors being displayed are in a generic text to be understandable by the user. A more technical description of the error is also available via the detail button. Note: Errors should be corrected before proceeding, when appropriate. If an error still exists when a referral certificate is generated the user will be asked to respond the following: “You have requested a certificate from a roster which</i></b>

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	<i>contains candidates who have errors in one or more of their database. These errors may affect their placement on this roster. Proceeding with your request to generate a certificate acknowledges this existence of these data errors. A copy of this certification will be placed on the Candidate Error Details Report. Do you wish to proceed with the generation of a certificate despite the existence of data errors? Click “yes” to proceed or click “no” to return back to the CRR without generating a certificate.” If “yes” is selected a timestamp of this acceptance will be displayed on the error section of the CRR report.</i>
<b>Edit Tracking Code Capability</b>	PROBLEM: The functionality of manually sending tracking codes back to Resumix is disabled when the CRR is placed in a “semi-read only” status. <b>FIX: The capability to manually sends tracking codes back to Resumix is restored.</b>
<b>Transferring CRRs</b>	PROBLEM: Once you generate a Certificate the users capability to transfer that CRR to another user is disabled. <b>FIX: The capability to transfer the CRR after the certificate has been issued or tracking codes have been sent back to Resumix has been restored.</b>
<b>Random Digit Sorting</b>	PROBLEM: The Random Digit used to break ties is not being displayed on the CRR property sheet. <b>FIX: The Random Digit is now being displayed on the CRR property sheet.</b>
<b>Resumix Requisition Notes Area</b>	PROBLEM: An error was received when the imported match list had notes in the Resumix Requisition with a Resumix user id in upper case. <b>FIX: The system has been fixed.</b>
<b>Just A Reminder</b>	The “Change Score” functionality was provided in the Aug 02 release. Any users needing this functionality should talk to their supervisor and system administrator. The system administrator, once approved by the supervisor, will work with the AFPC/DPCX staff to provide this capability.
