PROBLEM : **PERSONNEL** **PAYROLL**

NOT-TO-EXCEED DATES GREATER THAN 2009. DCPS determines the date century value (19 or 20) based on the year (99, 00, 01, etc.). DCPS edits only set the century value to '20' if the year is less than '10'. If a Not-To-Exceed (NTE) date sent through the interface is greater than 2009 DCPS sets the century value to '19' creating an invalid date condition. The transaction is erroneously rejecting back to Personnel. Additionally, DCPS will not allow online entry of a NTE date greater than 2009.

WORKAROUND: **PERSONNEL** **PAYROLL**

PERSONNEL: Personnel must fax the SF-50 for employees with a Not-To-Exceed Date greater than 2009 citing this Workaround Number.

PAYROLL: Payroll must enter the SF50 using a NTE date of 2009. Payroll must maintain a listing of employees along with the correct NTE date year value to update in DCPS once the SCR is released.
