SUBJECT: SUSPENSION OF ARABIC (DLPT) IV FORM E READING AND FORM F LISTENING

1. Per guidance from the Office of the Secretary of Defense, this message applies to all Services that maintain and administer Defense Foreign Language Program (DFLP) exams.

2. The Arabic DLPT IV Form **E Reading** and Form **F Listening** are immediately suspended and shall not be used after 9 June 2004 until further guidance is received from this office. The Defense Language Institute and Foreign Language Center (DLIFLC), Monterey, CA is presently conducting research on portions of the Arabic DLPT IV.

3. TCOs in possession of the following test components shall cease using them -- do NOT destroy them --upon receipt of this message:

4. Until further guidance is received from this office, TCOs shall segregate the above listed material from the current inventory. Suspended test material should be wrapped or placed in envelopes, and, if possible, stored in a separate drawer or safe from the current material. Packages will be labeled with the following notation:

“DO NOT USE” Test components suspended as of 9 Jun 2004; do not use until further guidance is received from HQ AFPC/DPPPWT.

5. Per guidance from DLIFLC, TCOs that receive requests for the Arabic DLPT shall administer the Arabic DLPT IV Form **E Listening** and Arabic DLPT IV Form **F Reading**.
